MDUSBC SENIOR MASTERS QUALIFYING SET FOR REGAL LANES

The Metro Detroit USBC Senior Masters Tournament qualifying is slated to begin at 8 a.m. Saturday, Feb. 11 at Regal Lanes in Warren.

Qualifying will be conducted in two squads on Feb. 11. After the six games of qualifying is completed the top players plus defending champion Terry Bialkowski of Windsor will return for double elimination match play on Sunday, Feb. 12. The top eight players after the first day of match play will come back on Saturday, Feb. 18 to complete the competition. Matches consist of two games total pins.

First place will pay \$2,500 with \$1,200 for runner-up, based on 120 entries.

The star studded field includes Ed Austreng of Waterford Township (Senior Masters champion 2005), Terence Dockery of Fraser (Masters 1993), Joe Krajenke of Clinton Township (Masters 1999), Harold Sullins of Chesterfield (Senior Masters 2012, 2013 and 2014) and Larry Walker of Garden City (Senior Masters 2009).
