DARREN ALEXANDER WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT WESTLAND BOWL

Darren Alexander of Essex, ON won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 181-162 triumph over Anthony Wright of Detroit at Westland Bowl. Alexander took home the top prize of \$500, while Wright settled for \$250.

Alexander qualified fourth in the field of 81, with a four-game total of 863 on games of 217, 204, 208 and 234. In match play he beat Charles Zelechowski of Westland 247-204, Elliot Smith of Southfield 238-228 and Noah Samuels of Canton 258-232 to advance to the championship match.

Wright qualified 15th with 794, including a high game of 213. In match play he defeated Mark Milasinovich of Shelby Twp 194-159, Dave Lacroix of Northville 209-208, Ryan Kelley of Riverview 200-189 and Devon Osborn of Farmington 222-200 on his way to the finals.

Samuels led the field with 993 on games of 245, 255, 248 and 245. In losing to Alexander, he added \$175 to his USBC SMART Scholarship account.
