BEN LAPOINTE WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL CANTON

Ben Lapointe of Sarnia, ON won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 269-213 triumph over Matthew Bederka of Romulus at Spins Bowl Canton. Lapointe took home the top prize of \$500, while Bederka earned \$250.

Lapointe qualified fourth in the field of 73, with a four-game total of 933 on games of 246, 240, 249 and 198. In match play he beat Jonathon Dean of Casco 256-201, Tom Reynolds of Ypsilanti 247-230 and Darren Alexander of Essex, ON 191-143 to advance to the championship match.

Bederka qualified sixth with 926, including a high game of 267. In match play he defeated Gregory Hall of Detroit 198-189, Jacob Giardina of Utica 237-228, and Conner Weber of Wayne 256-209 on his way to the finals.

Dylan Jablonski of Canton and college bowler for Concordia University was the top qualifier with 1047 on games of 277, 299, 267 and 204. He was eliminated in his first round of match play against Stephen Krywy of Sterling Heights 279-187. In losing his first match he earned \$75 that will go into his SMART Scholarship Fund.
