## CONNER WEBER WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT WESTLAND BOWL

Conner Weber of Wayne won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 243-189 triumph over Corey Miller of Waterford at Westland Bowl. Weber took home the top prize of \$500 while Miller earned \$250.

Weber qualified third in the field of 83, with a four-game total of 936 on games of 181, 269, 245 and 241. In match play he beat Mike Calhoun of Wyandotte 176-170, Darren Alexander of Essex, ON 263-258 and Dylan Jablonski of Canton 235-205 to advance to the championship match.

Miller qualified 12<sup>th</sup> with 895, including a high game of 248. In match play he defeated Gerald Johnson of Taylor 239-213, Dennis Johnson of Wyoming 243-190, and Mark Milasinovich of Shelby Twp. 279-235 on his way to the finals.

Milasinovich was the top qualifier with a four-game total of 991 on games of 236, 256, 266 and 233. In match play, he defeated last month's winner, Ben Lapointe of Sarnia, ON 288-145 and Brandon Leavitt of Novi 256-148 before losing to Miller.
