ANDRE GONZALES WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Andre Gonzales of Utica won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event Sunday with a 278-195 triumph over Jacob Johnson of Redford at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. Gonzales took home the top prize of \$500, while Johnson earned \$250.

Gonzales of Utica qualified sixth in the field of 82, with a four-game total of 955 on games of 238, 226, 279 and 212. In match play he beat Justina O'Hara of Van Buren Twp 186-166, Corey Miller of Waterford 201-190 and Matthew Bederka of Romulus 248-234 to advance to the championship match.

Johnson qualified first with 990, including a high game of 277. In match play he defeated Tom Reynolds of Ypsilanti 222-164, last month's winner Conner Weber of Wayne 226-182 and Charles Zelechowski of Westland 256-210 on his way to the finals.

In his first round of match play, Darren Alexander of Essex, ON shot a 300 game. In losing his next match to Bederka, Alexander earned \$125.
