COREY MILLER WINS MEN'S SERIES INVITATIONAL AT SHELBY LANES

Corey Miller of Waterford won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series Invitational event on Sunday with a 255-208 triumph over Christopher Steward of Waterford. Miller took home the top prize of \$500, while Steward settled for \$250.

Miller was the top qualifier in the invitational field of 16 with a four-game total of 899 on games of 224, 280, 192 and 203 to advance to the stepladder finals and wait for a challenger.

Steward qualified third with 845 on games of 188, 213, 220 and 224. In the stepladder finals he beat Michael Dickerson of Detroit 199-174 and Terrance Bell of Pontiac 203-164 on his way to the finals.

Bell cashed for \$150 and Dickerson \$100.

The top 16 on the points list of the five-event Men's Series were invited to participate in the special event at Shelby Lanes.

After the competition the top 15 in the points list were awarded their checks during a luncheon.

Stephen Krywy of Sterling Heights won the Men's Series cup with 769 points for \$600 for the five-event series, followed by Michael McCleskey of Southfield with 731 points for \$300 and Ryan Land of Royal Oak with 677 points for \$200.
