ANGELA WILT WINS WOMEN'S SERIES TITLE AT FORD LANES

Angela Wilt of Westland won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 199-189 triumph over Julie Oczepek of Reese at Ford Lanes in Dearborn Heights. Wilt took home the top prize of \$500, while Oczepek settled for \$250.

Wilt qualified eighth in the field of 24 by only two pins with a four-game total of 781. In qualifying she started with 228 and barely hung on with a final game of 170. In match play she beat top seed Lisa Bishop of Redford 191-180 and Amanda Barry of Clinton Township 212-180 to move on to the finals. Wilt as a result of this performance finished eighth in the MDUSBC Cup standings with 713 points.

Oczepek qualified second with 935, with a high game of 252. She beat Lauren Roberts of Warren 239-191 and Brandie Reamy of Livonia 256-206 to advance to the finals. Even with her second place finish Oczepek failed to make the top point getters to earn an invitation to the Rip 10 Invitational.

Lisa Bishop was the top qualifier for the second event in a row with 954 and the high game of the day with 288. She lost her first match earning \$50.

Brandie Reamy won the MDUSBC Cup with 827 points over Lisa Bishop, who had 807 points. Reamy won two events during the season along with other top finishes to secure the title.

The next MDUSBC Women's Series event will be the Rip 10 Invitational on May 7 at Shelby Lanes in Shelby Township.
