# CROWELL, TIMMER, AUSTRENG AND CATCHPOLE CAPTAIN MDUSBC ALL-CITY TEAMS

The Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) has named their All-City teams for the 2023-24 season. The Metro Detroit USBC Association is the largest local association of the United States Bowling Congress with over 30,000 adult and youth members.

The teams include men's, women's, senior men's and senior women's teams based on tournament and league performance from August 1, 2023 through July 31, 2024. A complete list of criteria is available at mdusbc.com. Points are tabulated on performance in local, state and national tournaments; honor scores and league averages.

Perry Crowell IV of St. Clair Shores captains the men's team while Stacy Timmer of Wayland, Jeffrey Austreng of Waterford and Teresa Catchpole of Macomb captain the women's, senior men's and senior women's teams respectively.

### Men's All-City Teams:

Crowell earned 93 points by being the first from MDUSBC in the Michigan State USBC Open Doubles with Andrew Anderson, third from MDUSBC in the USBC Open Singles and first from MDUSBC in the USBC Open All Events. A high average of 240, five 300 games, one 299 game, and three 800 series complete his resume. This marks the fourth appearance for Crowell on the All-City team.

Rounding out the Men's first team are Scott Bowersock of Dearborn Heights (87), Andrew Bennett of Royal Oak (78), John Kelley of Clinton Twp. (74) and Nicholas Cooper of Flint (73).

Bowersock finished second in Singles and first in All Events at the MDUSBC Open. In completing his resume, Bowersock rolled six 300 and three 299 games, seven 800 series and had a high average of 246. This marks the seventh appearance for Bowersock on the All-City team.

Bennett finished sixth from MDUSBC in the Michigan State USBC Open Doubles with James Williams and first overall in All-Events. In completing his resume, Bennett had a high average of 251, two 300 games and four 800 series. This marks the first appearance for Bennett on the All-City team.

Kelley finished first in Doubles with Ryan VanHecke, ninth in Singles and sixth in All Events at the MDUSBC Open Tournament and 11<sup>th</sup> at the MDUSBC Masters. In completing his resume, Kelley had three 300 games, 3 800 series and a high average of 240. This marks the ninth appearance for Kelley on the All-City team.

Cooper finished fourth in Singles and seventh in All Events at the MDUSBC Open. At the Michigan State USBC Open, Cooper finished seventh from MDUSBC in Doubles with Erin Cooper, ninth from MDUSBC in Singles and third from MDUSBC in All Events. In completing his resume, Cooper had four 300 games, one 299 game, two 800 series and a high average of 239. This marks the fourth appearance for Cooper on the All-City team.

Jacob Johnson of Redford (68), Jeffrey Austreng of Waterford (64), Scott Jones of Livonia (61), Corey Miller of Waterford (61) and Timothy Bishop of Livonia (60) made the Men's All-City Second Team. Johnson and Jones are making their first appearance, Austreng his sixteenth, Miller his fifth and Bishop his second on the Men's All-City Team.

# Women's All-City Teams:

Timmer with 104 points performed well in both the local and state events. She finished fourth with Brandie Reamy-Johnson and second in All Events at the MDUSBC Women's Championship. At the Michigan State USBC Women's, she finished first overall in Singles and second from MDUSBC in All Events. In the State Queen's event, Timmer finished second from MDUSBC and third overall. In completing her resume, Timmer had two 300 games, one 800 and six 700 series and a high average of 217. This marks the third appearance for Timmer on the Women's All-City Team.

Rounding out the Women's first team are Teresa Catchpole of Macomb (70), Shannon Rowe of Westland (68), Ashley Denard of Southfield (66) and Brandie Reamy-Johnson of Taylor (61.5).

Catchpole finished second from MDUSBC in the USBC Women's Doubles with Jennifer Peretto-Driscoll and first from MDUSBC in Singles. In completing her resume, Catchpole had one 300, one 299 and four other 279 plus games, 10 – 700 series and a high average of 221. This marks the sixth appearance for Catchpole on the Women's All-City Team.

Rowe won both one individual event and the overall Women's Turbo Cup Series. At the MDUSBC Women's, Rowe finished third in Doubles with Veronica Connors-Burge and fifth in singles. In addition, she was second from MDUSBC in singles and first in All Events at the USBC Women's Open. At the MDUSBC Queens, Rowe finished in second place. In completing her resume, Rowe had one 700 series and a high average of 210. This marks the fourth appearance for Rowe on the Women's All-City Team.

Denard finished third in Doubles with Brandie Reamy-Johnson and second in singles from MDUSBC at the Michigan State USBC Women's. At the State Queens, she finished fifth from MDUSBC. At the MDUSBC Open, Denard took first in Singles and eighth in All Events. In completing her resume, Denard had five 279 plus games, one 800 and five 700 series as well as a high average of 199. This marks the sixth appearance on the Women's All-City Team.

Reamy-Johnson tied for first in Doubles with Nicole Wilson and second in singles at the MDUSBC Women's, third in Doubles with Ashley Denard and fourth in All Events from MDUSBC at the Michigan State USBC Women's, 13<sup>th</sup> at the MDUSBC Queens and fourth from MDUSBC in the State Queens. In completing her resume, Reamy-Johnson had a high average of 217. This marks the sixth appearance for Reamy-Johnson on the Women's All-City Team.

Elizabeth Payeur of Ann Arbor (60), Victoria Giardina of Shelby Twp. (54), Jennifer Peretto-Driscoll of St. Clair Shores (52), Candyce Bradley of Farmington Hills (48) and Denisyha Waller of Shelby Twp.(47) made the Women's All City Second Team. This marks the first appearance for Payeur, Giardina and Peretto-Driscoll, and the second appearance for Bradley and Waller on the Women's All-City Team.

#### **Senior Men's All-City Team:**

Austreng, 102 points, makes his fourth appearance on the Senior Men's Team. In Senior finishes, Austreng placed in the following positions at the MDUSBC Open: first in Doubles with Charles Easton, second in Singles and sixth in All Events. At the MDUSBC Masters he was first for Seniors and at the MDUSBC Senior Masters he finished sixth. In completing his resume, Austreng had two 300 games, two 800 series and a high average of 242.

The Senior Men's First Team was completed by Gerald Sikora of Ecorse (67), Michael Calvin of Warren (43), Kenneth Wyatt of Sterling Heights (43) and Stephen Krywy of Warren (41).

Sikora finished second for Seniors at the MDUSBC Masters and second from MDUSBC at the Michigan State Senior Masters. In completing his resume, Sikora had three 300 games, two 800 series and a high average of 227. This marks Sikora's second appearance on the Senior Men's All-City Team.

Calvin finished second at the MDUSBC Senior Masters and first from MDUSBC at the USBC Senior Masters. In addition, he had a high average of 218. This marks Calvin's fourth Senior Men's All-City Team.

Wyatt's finishes among MDUSBC Seniors at the Michigan State USBC Open includes second in Doubles with Vernon Peterson, eighth in Singles and second for All Events. In addition, he had a high average of 236. This marks Wyatt's 12<sup>th</sup> appearance on the Senior Men's All-City Team.

Krywy finished 32<sup>nd</sup> at the MDUSBC Senior Masters and first from MDUSBC at the Michigan State USBC Senior Masters. In closing out his resume, Krywy had one 300 game, one 800 series and a high average of 235. This marks Krywy's third appearance on the Senior Men's All-City Team.

Earl Anthony of Detroit (36), Craig Bosco of St. Clair Shores (36), Thomas Landy of Macomb (34), John Talon of Ypsilanti (34), Bradley Gray of Farmington Hills (32), Mark Robertson of Warren (32) and Richard Wayne of Westland

(32) made the Senior Men's All-City Second Team. This marks the first appearance for Anthony, Bosco, Landy, Robertson and Wayne as well as the second appearance for Gray on the Senior Men's All-City Team.

# Senior Women's All-City Team:

Catchpole, 114 points, had the following finishes for Seniors at the MDUSBC Women's, including: seventh in Doubles with Pamela Jones, fifth in Singles and 10<sup>th</sup> in All Events. At the Michigan State USBC Women's she had the following Senior MDUSBC finishes, including: fourth in Doubles with Jeanne Gebbia, sixth in Singles and first in All Events. At the USBC Women's, she had the following finishes for MDUSBC Seniors: first in Doubles with Jennifer Peretto-Driscoll and first in Singles. Catchpole finished ninth at the MDUSBC Senior Queens. In completing her resume, Catchpole had one 300, one 299 and four other 279 plus games, 10 – 700 series and a high average of 221. This marks the eighth appearance on the Senior Women's All-City Team for Catchpole.

Rounding out the Senior Women's first team are Sandra Schultz of Macomb (74), Julie Halstead of Redford (64), Angela Wilt of Westland (50) and Deborah Murrell of Shelby Twp. (48). This marks the twelfth appearance for Shultz, first for Halstead, second for Wilt and fifth for Murrell on the Senior Women's All-City team.

Schultz had the following finishes for Seniors in the MDUSBC Women's, including: sixth in Doubles with Carlee Easton, third in singles and third in All Events. She finished second among Seniors in the MDUSBC Queens and first in the MDUSBC Senior Queens. Schultz was also first among MDUSBC bowlers at the USBC Senior Queens. In completing her resume, Shultz had one 700 series and a high average of 210.

Halstead had the following finishes for Seniors in the MDUSBC Women's, including: second in Doubles with Michelle Berryman, 10<sup>th</sup> in Singles and sixth in All Events. At the Michigan State USBC Women's she had the following Senior MDUSBC finishes, including fourth in both Singles and All Events. She finished second among MDUSBC Seniors at the USBC Women's. Halstead finished fourth among Seniors at the MDUSBC Queens and seventh at the MDUSBC Senior Queens. She had a high average of 216.

Wilt had the following finishes for MDUSBC Seniors at the Michigan State USBC Women's including third in Doubles with Sara Litteral, first in Singles and third in All Events. At the MDUSBC Queens, Wilt finished third among Seniors. In completing her resume, she had one 300 game and a high average of 209.

Murrell finished first among Seniors in Doubles with Jeanne Gebbia at the MDUSBC Women's and second among Seniors for Singles in the same event. In completing her resume, she had one 300 and one 298 game, one 800 series and a high average of 208.

Joining the second team were Jeanne Gebbia (39), Lesia Lambert (37), Michelle Berryman (31), Toary Taylor (29) and Kamla Sand (26). This marks the first appearance for Sand and Lambert, second for Berryman, sixth for Gebbia and 10<sup>th</sup> for Taylor on the Senior All-City Team.
