BAILEY GIPSON WINS WOMEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL CANTON

Bailey Gipson of Davison won a match down to the final ball in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 234-233 triumph over Ashley Denard of Southfield at Spins Bowl Canton. Gipson took home the top prize of \$500, while Denard earned \$250.

Gipson who also won the Series Mixed Baker Doubles on October 8th with Jacob Johnson of Redford qualified first in the field of 44, with a four-game total of 951 on games of 256, 225, 245 and 225. In reaching the finals against Denard, she beat Latasha Cole of Detroit 201-193 and Mykaela Mitchell of Windsor, ON 205-190.

Denard qualified 10th with 834, which included games of 178, 235, 204 and 217. In reaching the finals against Gipson, she defeated last year's first event champion Sarah Dorow of Midland 259-164, Tamika Glenn of Belleville 223-202 and Denisyha Waller of Shelby Twp. 222-218.

Waller qualified third and had the high game of the women's event with a 268 in the second game of the qualifying rounds.
