CARLETON CHAMBERS WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT WESTLAND BOWL

Carleton Chambers was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 211-181 triumph over James Larsen of New Baltimore at Westland Bowl. Chambers took home the top prize of \$500 while Larsen earned \$250.

Chambers qualified 16th in the field of 71 with a four-game total of 816 on games of 201, 177, 220 and 218. In reaching the finals against Larsen, he beat Dennis Dautel of Midland 243-193, Lonnie Olsen of Macomb 235-218, Avery North of Ypsilanti 191-184 and Diandre Moreland of Detroit 210-176.

Larsen qualified 14th with 828, which included games of 206, 194, 189 and 239. In reaching the finals against Chambers, he defeated Michael Dickerson of Detroit 200-150 and Philip Zocharski of Chelsea 189-179 and Dennis Berryman of Brighton 182-173.

Olsen qualified first with a four-game total of 964 on games of 247, 213, 229 and 275 while Logan Mills of Plymouth had high game with a perfect 300.
