CARLETON CHAMBERS WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Carleton Chambers of Detroit was victorious for a second time in a row in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 223-210 triumph over Dylan Jablonski of Canton at Spins Bowl Waterford. Chambers took home the top prize of \$500 while Jablonski earned \$250.

Chambers qualified 10th in the field of 71 with a four-game total of 887 on games of 204, 247, 231 and 205. In reaching the finals against Jablonski, he beat Matt Rist of Garden City 277-255, Chris Beaulieu of Windsor 200-189 and Gerald Johnson of Taylor 223-193.

Jablonski qualified first with 983, which included games of 255, 217, 256 and 255. In reaching the finals against Chambers, he defeated Conner Weber of Wayne 233-180, Mark Milasinovich of Shelby Twp. 246-245 and Matthew Bederka of Romulus 255-216.

High game of the day, 280, went to Connor Rogus of Macomb. He qualified second with a total of 967 before losing his first match play round to Beaulieu 235-162. Rogus earned \$75 for his efforts.
