MATTHEW BEDERKA WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Matthew Bederka of Romulus was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 228-200 triumph over Nathan Roberts of Allen Park at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. Bederka took home the top prize of \$500 while Roberts earned \$250.

Bederka qualified 17th in the field of 77 with a four-game total of 852 on games of 174, 209, 244 and 225. In reaching the finals against Roberts, he beat Brandon Clark of Inkster 225-193, Darren Alexander of Essex, ON 195-185, defending champion Carleton Chambers of Detroit 214-197 and Logan Mills of Plymouth 248-168.

Roberts qualified 18th with 851, which included games of 233, 208, 195 and 215. In reaching the finals against Bederka, he defeated Gregory Hall of Detroit 244-178, Jarin Kurashige of Sterling Heights 223-188, Charles Easton of Toldeo 249-225 and Matt Rist of Garden City 207-190

Alexander qualified first with 953 and a high game of 247. Kurashige who qualified second had high game of the day with a perfect 300.
