NATHAN ROBERTS WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT TOWN N COUNTRY LANES LANES

Nathan Roberts of Allen Park was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 234-198 triumph over Dylin Hunter of Windsor, ON at Town N Country Lanes in Westland. Roberts took home the top prize of \$500 while Hunter earned \$250.

Roberts was the runner up in the last Series event and qualified fifth in this event's field of 72 with a four-game total of 929 on games of 235, 270, 257 and 167. In reaching the finals against Hunter, he beat Jacob Kujawa of Sterling Heights 212-204, Andrew Bradford of Ypsilanti 256-193, and Phil Zocharski of Chelsea 210-172.

Hunter qualified 10th with 879, which included games of 258, 194, 213 and 214. In reaching the finals against Roberts, he defeated Steve Kenyon of Grosse Ile 201-194, Jacob Johnson of Redford 191-184 and David Winters of Livonia 258-247.

Zocharski qualified first with 994 including a perfect game of 300. Jeffrey Elswick Jr. of Romulus also rolled a perfect game of 300 in this event.
