LATASHA COLE WINS WOMEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT TOWN N COUNTRY LANES

Latasha Cole was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 227-203 triumph over Angela Wilt of Westland at Town N Country Lanes in Westland. Cole took home the top prize of \$500 while Wilt earned \$250.

Cole qualified seventh in the in the field of 32 with a four-game total of 794 on games of 193, 171, 215 and another 215. In reaching the finals against Wilt, she beat the last event's champion, Victoria Giardina of Shelby Twp. 182-169 and Brandie Reamy-Johnson of Taylor 241-225.

Wilt qualified fifth with 815, which included games of 189, 209, 211 and 206. In reaching the finals against Cole, she defeated Kristin Truszkowski of Livonia 198-180 and Emily Rettig of Novi 197-182.

Rettig qualified first with a four-game total of 972 on games of 213, 245, 288 and 226.
