SHANNON ROWE WINS WOMEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Shannon Rowe of Westland was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 182-175 triumph over Angela Wilt also of Westland at Spins Bowl Waterford. Rowe took home the top prize of \$500 while Wilt earned \$250.

Rowe qualified fourth in the field of 24 with a four-game total of 809 on games of 235, 209,197 and 168. In reaching the finals against Wilt, she beat Sara Litteral of Redford 235-213 and last month's champion, Victoria Giardina of Shelby Twp 196-170.

Wilt qualified third with 823, which included games of 177, 212, 178 and 256. In reaching the finals against Rowe, she defeated Emily Gurin of Dearborn Heights 184-147 and Mykaela Hunter of Windsor 212-199.

Emily Rettig of Novi qualified first with a four-game total of 932 on games of 279, 186, 244 and 223. She lost in the first round to Giardina 208-183 and earned \$50 for her efforts.
