Adult / Youth Baker Doubles Tournament

-Rules-

- 1. Eligibility:** This event is open to all 2023-24 certified USBC youth members. All adult bowlers must be a USBC certified member in good standing or if not presently a 2023-24 USBC member, pay a \$5 per entry participant fee. **Participant fee entries are not eligible for USBC awards. Current USBC membership cards must be shown at check-in**
- 2. Entry Fee & Deadline Date:** A \$60.00 entry fee must be paid at the time of entry. Entries postmarked or received after June 30, 2024 will be \$70.00. Walk-ins and re-entries will be \$70.00 on a cash only, first-come, first-served basis if space permits.
Junior Gold Registration: Entries will also be accepted at the Jr Gold registration at the Metro Detroit USBC Association booth - **\$70.00 (cash or credit card only)**
On-Site Registration: Entries may also be dropped off at Town N Country Lanes **after June 30, 2024** and cost **\$70.00 (cash or credit card only)**. Acceptance will be on a first-come, first-serve basis, based upon squad time and lane availability once the entry is transferred to the tournament staff.
- 3. Teams and Divisions:** Each doubles team consists of a USBC youth bowler and a USBC adult bowler. All youth bowlers are eligible to bowl in this tournament whether or not they are participating in the Junior Gold or Youth Open events. U20 bowlers can bowl as an adult for this tournament. There will be separate Boys and Girls divisions in U12, U15, and U18. The age of the youth bowler as of August 1st, 2023 will determine the division.
- 4. Format:** Each doubles team will bowl four (4) Baker-style games. Baker-style games are where ne bowler throws the first frame and their partner throws the next frame. The youth bowler will be on the odd (left) lane and the adult on the even (right) lane. The youth bowler will begin games 1 and 3; the adult will begin 2 and 4. Teams will bowl all 4 games on the same pair of lanes. The lane condition will be a modified house pattern with re-dressing of lanes between the 11:30am and 2:30pm squads. This is a USBC certified scratch tournament.
- 5. Scholarships:** The scholarship portion of the entry fee will be returned 100% with scholarships held in the USBC SMART Program in Arlington, TX. Scholarships will be awarded on at least a 1:6 ratio or major portion thereof in each division. A USBC youth bowler may receive multiple scholarships in this tournament; however, they may only receive 1 scholarship with the same partner. For more Info on the SMART Program, Go to **Bowl.com**
