CHELSEY KLINGLER WINS MDUSBC QUEENS AT VISION LANES

Chelsey Klingler of Cedar Springs defeated Julie Oczepek of Vassar 225-183 in the final match to win the MDUSBC Queens at Vision Lanes in Westland. Klingler won the title and \$1,300 while Oczepek earned \$500.

Klingler qualified was the top qualifier with a six-game total of 1,416 on games of 268, 266, 257, 211, 203 and 211. In match play, she beat Rachel Lawrence of Westland 235-188 and defending champion Kristin Truskowski of Livonia 227-216 on her way to the final match. She averaged 233.7 for 9 games of competition.

Oczepek qualified seventh with 1,330 and a high game of 249. In match play, she beat Amanda Barry of Clinton Twp. 231-222, Dasha Kovalova of Muskegon 217-204 and Sara Litteral of Redford 241-232 leading to the championship match. She averaged 220.2 for 10 games.

The high game for the event, 290, was shot by fourth seed, Denisyha Waller of Shelby Twp. She lost in the second round of match play and earned \$100.

The top four non-cashing seniors, 50 years and older, earned \$60 each. This group included Sandra Schultz of Macomb, Angela Wilt of Westland, Toary Taylor of West Bloomfield and Lesia Lambert of Allen Park.
