JUSTIN KNOWLES WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL STERLING

Justin Knowles of Okemos won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 223-219 win over Ryan Land of Royal Oak at Spins Bowl Sterling in Sterling Heights. Knowles took home the top prize of \$500, while Land settled for \$250.

Knowles qualified first in the field of 67, with a four-game total of 1,018 on games of 279, 268, 213 and 258. In match play Lee Papocchia of Newport 259-201, Mark Milasinovich of Shelby Township 225-216 and Daniel Pollak of Fraser 245-189 to advance to the championship match.

Land qualified third with 967, including a high game of 259. In match play he beat Nick Eaton of Wyoming 224-186, Christopher Steward of Waterford 236-202 and Michael Piccininni of Warren 244-214 on his way to the finals.

Steve Kenyon of Grosse Ile took over the season long cup list with 295 points, closely followed by Land (291), Stephen Krywy (290) of Sterling Heights and Michael McCleskey (285) of Southfield. The next event will be double points at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park on March 28.
