MADCHEN BREEN AND MARCUS McCLAIN WIN MDUSBC JUNIOR MASTERS TITLES AT AIRWAY LANES

Marcus McClain of Lincoln Park prevailed in the boy's division and Madchen Breen of Warren won the girl's division of the Metro Detroit USBC Association Junior Masters at Airway Lanes in Waterford.

McClain defeated top seed Ryan Winters of Livonia 215-159 to win the boy's division after defeating Justin O'Shaughnessy of Canton 179-129 and Jordan Bryant of Detroit 199-192 to advance to the final match.

Top seed Breen beat Keri Molloy of Sandusky 193-141 to capture the girl's division.

Winters was the top qualifier among the boys with a six-game total of 1,321. McClain qualified fourth with 1,192.

Breen was the girl's top qualifier with 1,121, while Molloy qualified second among the girls with 1,110.

The boy's stepladder finals began with Justin O'Shaughnessy beating Jacob Kersten of Clarkston 192-188. O'Shaughnessy then fell to McClain 179-129.

The girl's stepladder finals kicked off with Tryna Gladstone of Lake Orion beating Samantha Gainor of New Baltimore 197-193 before losing to Molloy 191-185.
