JACOB JOHNSON WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL

Jacob Johnson of Redford won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 256-237 triumph over Gerald Johnson of Taylor at Thunderbowl in Allen Park. Jacob Johnson took home the top prize of \$500, while Gerald Johnson settled for \$250.

Jacob Johnson qualified 15th in the field of 90, with a four-game total of 843 on games of 222, 190, 210 and 221. In match play he beat Ken Rogers of Livonia 214-170, Raymond Cerekas of Warren 188-156, Dennis Johnson of Wyoming of Wyoming 236-198 and December's champion Darren Alexander of Essex, Ontario 211-202 to advance to the championship match.

Gerald Johnson qualified 13th with 845, including a high game of 244. In match play he defeated Dylan Kelley of Shelby Twp 300-200, Carleton Chambers of Detroit 236-224, Drake Bazzy of Flat Rock 259-256 and Corey Miller of Waterford 257-196 on his way to the finals.

Jonathan Dean of Casco led the field with 978 on games of 278, 181, 239 and 280. In losing to Miller, he earned \$125.
