SCOTT GLENDAY WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT STERLING LANES

Scott Glenday of Warren won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a triumph over Anthony Wright of Detroit 230-229 at Sterling Lanes in Sterling Heights. Glenday took home the top prize of \$500, while Wright settled for \$250.

Glenday qualified 10th in the field of 96, with a four-game total of 951 on games of 238, 247, 209 and 257. In reaching the finals against Wright, he beat Lonnie Olsen of Macomb 243-172, Floyd Raymond of Clinton Twp 238-223, Michael Calhoun of Wyandotte 278-248, and Kristofer Dettloff of Davisburg 210-179.

Wright qualified 12th with 947, which included games of 248, 203, 275 and 221. In reaching the finals against Glenday, he defeated Harry Kosmala of Macomb 229-213, Gerald Johnson of Taylor 232-195, Darren Alexander of Essex, Ontario 210-195 and Chris Clark of Lowell 263-168.

Lamont Walters of Redford was the top qualifier with 1039, including games of 268, 237, 246 and 288. In losing to Clark, he earned \$100.
