VICTORIA GIARDINA WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT WESTLAND BOWL

Victoria Giardina of Shelby Twp won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 225-145 triumph over Rachel Lawrence of Westland at Westland Bowl. Giardina took home the top prize of \$500, while Lawrence settled for \$250.

Giardina qualified tenth in the field of 41, with a four-game total of 763 on games of 191, 157, 171 and 244. In reaching the finals against Lawrence, she beat Jennifer Clark of Lowell 209-199, Julia Huren of Westland 208-206 and Shannon Rowe also of Westland 216-201.

Lawrence qualified fourth with 802, which included games of 191, 211, 174 and 226. In reaching the finals against Giardina, she defeated Sarah Dorow of Midland 203-183 and Anna Maxwell of Westland 266-182.

Maxwell was the top qualifier with 855, including games of 210, 184, 224 and 237. In losing to Lawrence, she added \$100 to her USBC SMART Scholarship account. .
