RULES & REGULATIONS — 500 Club Tournament

1. This shall be a singles handicap tournament. Handicap will be 100% of 230 scratch. Three games to be bowled on one pair of lanes. Tournament is USBC certified and all USBC rules and regulations will govern. Only USBC certified female members may participate and they must have bowled a 500 series in their lifetime. Current (2022-2023) USBC membership card must be presented at the time of check in.
2. Entry Fee shall be \$27.00 per person.
3. Each participant may enter only once.
4. Prize monies will be returned 100% on a ratio of at least one prize for each 10 entries. In the event of a tie for first place, first and second place prize monies will be combined and divided equally.
5. All averages, including summer, are considered in the following order:
 - A. Highest 2021-2022 USBC average with 21 games or more
 - B. Highest 2020-2021 USBC average with 21 games or more
 - C. Highest average with 21 games or more as of December 1, 2022 (with verification).
 - D. If no December 1st use 230.
6. It shall be the player's responsibility to determine that the submitted average is correct. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average or prize winnings will be based on submitted average if it is higher. Corrections in average may be made up to completion of first game.
7. Bowlers arriving late shall start in the frame being bowled. Zero shall be given for each frame missed.
8. No entry fees returned after closing date of tournament entries.
9. USBC Rule 319d (reporting prize winnings) does not apply.
10. USBC Rule 319a(2) (10 pin rule) does not apply.
11. USBC Rule 319e (average adjustment rule) does not apply.
12. **All bowling equipment must be approved by USBC and no bowling ball can be used prior to the release date to the public. If found using either of the above, the first action will be a warning followed by disqualification if continued to be used.**
13. Any individual submitting 8 or more paid entries at least 10 days before the tournament shall receive \$10 per 8 entries.
14. Participants must check in at tournament office one hour before starting time.
15. All decisions of the tournament management are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
