## ANDRE GONZALES WINS MDUSBC MASTERS AND CLAIMS \$2,200 FIRST PRIZE AT PLAZA LANES

Andre Gonzales of Saginaw became a champion in his first appearance in the 60<sup>th</sup> Annual Metro Detroit USBC Masters Championship by defeating Jordan Bryant of Detroit 394-337. In claiming the title, Gonzales was the lone survivor in the winner's bracket remaining undefeated throughout the tournament and claimed the \$2,200 first prize. Bryant settled for the second place check of \$1,100.

Gonzales qualified 10<sup>th</sup> with a six-game total of 1,249. In match play, he defeated Jeff Austreng of Waterford 438-374, Kurry Crayton of Pontiac 408-366, Anthony Wright of Detroit 494-421 and Carleton Chambers of Detroit 438-410 to advance to the final match. In the final match, Gonzales beat Bryant 394-337 to win the championship. Over the two-day tournament, Gonzales averaged 213.8 for 16 games.

Bryant qualified 11<sup>th</sup> with 1,244. In match play, he lost to Anthony Wright of Detroit 392-389 to fall into the loser's bracket. In the loser's bracket he beat Leon Lusane II of Ferndale 333-298, Cory Hersha of South Whitley, Indiana 466-321, Austreng 408-391, Wright 426-365, Mason Brantley of Detroit 385-369 and Chambers 403-372 to move to the final match. Bryant averaged 199.6 for 22 games of competition.

Chambers qualified fifth with 1,281. He remained in the winner's bracket by defeating Christopher Steward of Waterford 414-397, Hersha 408-383 and Kyle King of St. Clair Shores 418-349 before falling into the loser's bracket losing to Gonzales 438-410. Once in the loser's bracket he lost to Bryant 403-372 ending his run. Chambers averaged 206.4 for 16 games and settled for third place for \$900.

Brantley, the 2011 Masters champion, qualified fourth with 1,286. In match play, he lost to Hersha 381-364 falling into the loser's bracket. Once in the loser's bracket he beat Steward 443-356, Charles Easton of Sylvania, Ohio 525-421, Zachary Colosimo of Farmington Hills 489-360, King 470-405 before getting knocked out of the competition by Bryant 385-369. Brantley averaged 219.2 for 18 games of competition and settled for the fourth place check of \$700.

King qualified eighth with 1,253 and took home \$500 for his fifth place finish. Wright finished sixth for \$500, Austreng seventh for \$450 and Colosimo eighth for \$450.

Top qualifier Snodgrass won one match before losing and finishing ninth for \$400.

The MDUSBC Masters Tournament is a USBC certified event operated by the Metro Detroit USBC, the largest local association of the United States Bowling Congress which serves over 30,000 adult and youth bowlers in the Metropolitan Detroit market.
