KENNETH WYATT WINS \$1,000 FIRST PRIZE IN MDUSBC SUPER SENIOR MASTERS AT PLAZA LANES

Kenneth Wyatt of Sterling Heights won the MDUSBC Super Senior Masters title and the top prize of \$1,000 at Plaza Lanes in Plymouth with a 245-220 win over Larry Walker of Garden City. Walker settled for \$500.

Firs-time champion, Wyatt qualified seventh with a five-game total of 1,140. He remained in the winner's bracket with victories over Jimmy Magolan of Shelby Twp. 237-208, Eddie Mintz of Canton 268-248, Gerald Johnson of Taylor 226-211 and provided Walker his first loss of the double elimination format by the score of 256-245. He then had to wait for Walker to emerge from the loser's bracket. Once Walker emerged, he defeated Wyatt 279-233 to set up the final match. Wyatt averaged 236.82 for 11 games of competition.

Walker qualified 13th with 1,098, with a high game of 245. In match play he beat Daniel Kinjorski of Berkley 215-212 and defending champion Joe Krajenke of Clinton Twp.231-183 and Michael McCleskey of Southfield 236-217 before falling in the first match against Wyatt 256--245. In the loser's bracket he defeated Gerald Kopec of Sterling Heights 257-201 before beating Wyatt in their second match 279-233 to advance to the final match. Walker averaged 231.75 for 12 games.

Kopec finished third for \$400 and Michael Snow of Windsor, Ontario finished fourth for \$350.

Kopec qualified 11th with 1,105. He lost his first match to Snow 257-225, before beating Gerald Sikora of Ecorse 236-180, Krajenke 258-219, top qualifier Carl Harden of Livonia, 257-183 Johnson 237-228 and Snow 233-198 before losing to Walker 257-201 to end his day. For 11 games, Kopec averaged 231.91.

Harden was the top qualifier with 1,201. He won his first match over Ralph Meisner of Waterford 222-203 then lost to McCleskey 256-231. In the loser's bracket he won his first match over Magolan 221-212 before losing his final to Kopec 257-193. Harden averaged 230.88 for 8 games.

Rick Capaldi of Manitou Beach won the special competition for non-qualifiers over the age of 70 with a 220-217 win over Sam Girgenti of St. Clair Shores. Capaldi took home \$200 and Girgenti \$175 for their efforts.
