MATTHEW BEDERKA WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Matthew Bederka of Romulus was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 279-247 triumph over Andre Gonzales of Sterling Heights at Spins Bowl Waterford (Century Bowl). Bederka took home the top prize of \$500 while Gonzales earned \$250.

This is the second win of the season for Bederka in this Series event. In this event, qualified first in the field of 87 bowlers with a four-game total of 994 on games of 258, 246, 244 and 246. In reaching the finals against Gonzales, he beat Kurry Crayton of Pontiac 216-194, Matt Rist of Garden City 276-237 and Brandyn Huffman of Roseville 279-265.

Gonzales qualified 11th with 919, which included games of 280, 238, 192 and 209. In reaching the finals against Bederka, he defeated Anthony Dimuzio of Warren 288-258, Jarin Kurashige also of Warren 278-200, Terrance Bell of Pontiac 268-153 and Jordan Born of White Lake 217-211.

Born qualified second and had high game for the event with a 299 in the first game. He also had games of 206, 223 and 248 for a four-game total of 976.
