LATASHA COLE WINS WOMEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Brandie Reamy-Johnson of Taylor was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 269-181 triumph over Victoria Giardina of Shelby Twp. at Spins Bowl Waterford (Century Bowl). Reamy-Johnson took home the top prize of \$500 while Giardina earned \$250.

Reamy-Johnson qualified first in the in the field of 33 with a four-game total of 983 on games of 258, 268, 212 and 245. In reaching the finals against Giardina, she beat Lauren Krywy of Warren 236-190 and last month's winner Latasha Cole of Detroit 257-178.

Giardina, a two-time winner this season qualified seventh in this event with 898, which included games of 208, 246, 228 and 216. In reaching the finals against Reamy-Johnson, she defeated Bailey Gipson of Sterling Heights 236-230 and Laurin Prebelich of Macomb 252-223.

Cole had the high game of the event with 279 in the second game. She qualified fourth with a fourgame total of 933.
