VICTORIA GIARDINA WINS WOMEN'S "TURBO CUP" SERIES INVITATIONAL AT SHELBY LANES

Victoria Giardina of Shelby Twp won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series Invitational event on Sunday with a 266-172 triumph over Sandra Schultz of Macomb. Giardina took home the top prize of \$500, while Schultz earned \$250.

Giardina was the top qualifier in the invitational field of 19 with a four-game total of 961 on games of 259, 245, 222 and 235. In securing the top qualifying position, Giardina advanced to the stepladder finals.

Schultz qualified in the third position with a four-game total of 933 including a high game of 265. In her first match, Schultz beat Emily Gurin of Dearborn Heights 216-152. Gurin cashed for \$100. In her second match, she beat Mykaela Hunter of Windsor, ON 236-195 before advancing to the final match. Hunter earned \$150.

Bowlers qualified for the Invitational portion of the season long five-event series by finishing in the top 16 cumulative cup point list, winning a single event throughout the season or bowling in all five events.

After the competition, the event participants were awarded their checks during a luncheon.

Giardina earned \$600 for winning the Women's Turbo Cup with 856 points over the five-event series, followed by Brandie Reamy-Johnson of Taylor with 809 points for \$300 and Angela Wilt of Westland with 738 points for \$200.
