LAMONT WALTERS WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT IMPERIAL LANES

Lamont Walters of Redford was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 233-210 triumph over Gerald Johnson of Taylor at Imperial Lanes in Clinton Township. Walters took home the top prize of \$600 while Johnson earned \$300.

Walters qualified third in the field of 45 with a four-game total of 858 on games of 248, 178, 176 and 256. In reaching the finals against Johnson, he beat Darren Alexander of Essex, Ont. 187-171 and Nathan Roberts of Allen Park 182-180.

Johnson qualified ninth with 808, which included games of 217, 172, 203 and 216. In reaching the finals against Chambers, he defeated Zach Kilbourne of Linden 226-199, Matt Quist of Wyoming 210-175 and John Gardner of Hamburg Township 225-150.

Quist qualified first with a four-game total of 912 on games of 235, 246, 219 and 212. Brandon VanDeusen of Warren had the high game for the men at 259. He finished 19th in the Qualifying round with a four-game total of 770.
