DEVON OSBORN WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL CANTON

Devon Osborn of Farmington was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 256-184 triumph over Noah Samuels of Canton at Spins Bowl Canton (Super Bowl Lanes). Osborn took home the top prize of \$600 while Samuels earned \$300.

Osborn qualified fifth in the field of 77 with a four-game total of 920 on games of 247, 202, 235 and 236. In reaching the finals against Samuels, he beat Gordon Kaufman of Grand Blanc 233-230, Stacy Keith of New Boston 257-247 and Joseph Merz of Davison 235-227.

Samuels qualified 11th with 897, which included games of 246, 225, 201 and 225. In reaching the finals against Osborn, he defeated Steve Pydyn of Canton 225-181, Matt Rist of Garden City 220-194 and Tuna Boncu of Fort Wayne, IN 279-244.

It was slightly more than one month ago when Samuels and Osborn met in the Semi-Finals of the 2026 MDUSBC Masters Championship. Samuels won this match and became the eventual winner.

The top qualifier of this event was David Winters of Livonia with 953 on games of 268, 258, 236 and 191. He lost in his second round of Match-Play to Merz 253-212.
