NOAH SAMUELS WINS MEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Noah Samuels of Canton was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 210-194 triumph over Michael Snow of Windsor, Ont. at Spins Bowl Waterford (Century Bowl). Samuels took home the top prize of \$600 while Snow earned \$300.

Last month's runner-up, Samuels, qualified first in the field of 56 with a four-game total of 944 on games of 237, 216, 222 and 269. On his way to the win against Snow, he beat John Gardner of Hamburg Twp 258-169, Steve Kenyon of Grosse Ile 222-162 and Aaron Lorincz of Centerline 245-214.

Snow qualified third with 913, which included games of 248, 218, 226 and 221. In reaching the finals against Samuels, he defeated Gerald Johnson of Taylor 215-203, Danny Larocca of Pinckney 201-148 and Logan Mills of Plymouth 215-165.

Third and fourth place finishers were Lorincz who qualified fifth with 899 and a high game of 236 as well as Mills who qualified second with 924 and a high game of 244.
