ANNA MAXWELL WINS WOMEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT IMPERIAL LANES

Anna Maxwell of Westland was victorious in the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a 224-205 triumph over Sara Litteral of Redford at Imperial Lanes in Clinton Township. Maxwell took home the top prize of \$600 while Litteral earned \$300.

Maxwell qualified second in the field of 36 with a four-game total of 895 on games of 214, 223, 223 and 235. In reaching the finals against Litteral, she beat Brystal Beyer of Madison Heights 227-223 and Brandie Reamy-Johnson of Taylor 238-227.

Litteral qualified first with 920, which included games of 268, 247, 180 and 225. In reaching the finals against Maxwell, she defeated Sandra Schultz of Macomb 186-172 and Laurin Prebelich also of Macomb 232-140.

The top eight bowlers in the Qualifying rounds moved on to Match Play. Schultz tied for eighth with Lyric O'Steen of Southfield. In a one-game roll off, Schultz defeated O'Steen 243-209 to move forward into Match Play.
