BRystal BEYER WINS WOMEN'S TURBO CUP SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL CANTON

Brystal Beyer of Madison Heights won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Turbo Cup Series event on Sunday with a very close 206-205 triumph over Victoria Giardina of Shelby Twp. at Spins Bowl Canton (Super Bowl Lanes). Beyer took home the top prize of \$600 while Giardina earned \$300.

Beyer qualified second in the field of 19 with a four-game total of 911 on games of 264, 224, 177 and 246. In reaching the finals against Giardina, she beat Elizabeth Payeur of Ann Arbor 247-212 and Tamika Glenn of Belleville 243-198.

Giardina qualified fourth with 887, which included games of 221, 227, 218 and 221. In reaching the finals against Beyer, she defeated Emily Gurin of Dearborn Heights 234-182 and Shannon Rowe of Westland 234-185.

High game of the day, 266, went to the previous winner, Anna Maxwell of Westland, The next highest game, 264, went to Beyer.
