JULIE HALSTEAD CAPTURES MDUSBC SENIOR QUEENS AT IMPERIAL LANES

Julie Halstead of Redford won the Metro Detroit USBC Senior Queens on Saturday with a 259-214 triumph over Michelle Berryman of Brighton at Imperial Lanes in Clinton Twp.

Halstead was the third qualifier for the stepladder finals with a four-game total of 880 on games of 222, 221, 215 and 222. On her way to the stepladder finals, she beat Cyndi Patterson of Taylor 237-196 and Angela Wilt of Westland 248-212.

Berryman, the 2023 Senior Queens Champion, qualified first with a four-game total of 903 on games of 245, 248, 181 and 229. In qualifying first, she waited for Halstead to work her way through the stepladder to bowl against her in the finals

Wilt qualified second with a four-game total of 886 on games of 215, 258, 196 and 217 before losing to Halstead.

Patterson qualified fourth with a four-game total of 866 on games of 238, 219, 205 and 204 before losing to Halstead in the first round.

This was the 18th year of the MDUSBC Senior Queens. Initial qualifying was done by senior women 50 years of age and older with their actual all-events of the recently completed MDUSBC Women's Championship. The top bowlers advanced to the qualifying finals.
