3. If current membership cannot be verified by bowl.com, a USBC full membership must be purchased at the tournament site (USBC \$15, Michigan State USBC \$1.00 and their local association dues).
4. CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY:
 - A) A refund will be given, less \$25 cancellation fee, if written notice is received by October 25, 2025
 - B) No refund will be given if written notice is received after October 25, 2025
 - C) Those who withdraw/cancel may obtain their own replacements. Bowlers who obtain replacements will make their own arrangements as to repayment of their individual entry fees.
 - D) Tournament Director must be notified of replacements 48 hours before the tournament starts.

Entry Fee: \$125 before October 25, 2025 \$135 after October 25, 2025
Entire entry fee to be applied to prize fund.

Michigan State USBC Queens Tournament Rules

1. This is an individual scratch tournament open only to female Michigan State USBC members who have a 2024-25 bowl.com average (minimum 21 games) or are currently a member of a Michigan State USBC certified league (minimum 21 games). A collegiate member may bowl provided she has a Michigan certified average within the last 4 years.
2. Entry fee is \$ 125.00. Entire entry to be applied to prize fund and prize fund will be returned 100%.
Rule 319d is waived.
3. Walk-ins will be accepted based on lane availability Walk-in entry fee is \$135.00. Walk-ins will be accepted no later than one hour prior to the start of the tournament.
4. Bowlers must check in ONE HOUR before first scheduled time to bowl, to draw for lane assignments, and one-half hour prior to each squad thereafter.
5. Qualifying rounds will be as follows:
 - a. FIRST ROUND: All Bowlers
Saturday 10:00 am.- 5 games bowled
(Ball surface may be altered between squads)
Saturday 2:00 pm.- 5 games bowled
Each bowler will bowl two-five game blocks. The 10-game total pinfall will be used to qualify for the Second Round (Sunday morning).
Top sixteen qualifiers will advance to Sunday morning.
All advancers receive prize money.
The highest non-qualifying senior (50+) will receive prize money.
 - b. SECOND ROUND: Sunday 9:00 am - Sixteen bowlers (minimum) carrying pin count forward will bowl a 4-game block. The field will be cut to eight, and those eight bowlers, carrying pin count forward will bowl a 4-game block. (balls may be altered prior to the start of the step ladder finals) The top four will advance to the Stepladder Final Round.
 - c. FINAL ROUND-Stepladder Format: Four bowlers. Incoming bowler will have 2 practice balls on each lane) Top seed chooses who starts first. The four finalists will compete in one game matches in Stepladder format on one pair of lanes to determine the 2024 Michigan Queens Tournament Champion.
6. Entrants may not practice on tournament lanes on the day of qualifying.
7. Queens Tournament Champion will receive a Tiara, a Medallion, and if eligible, a paid entry into the next year's Michigan State Queens Tournament from the Michigan State USBC. In addition, a paid entry into the USBC Queens Tournament (must be used within two years) will be reimbursed upon proof of participation in same.

8. The application of any foreign substance on any part of the approach that detracts from the possibility of other players having normal conditions is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, talcum powder, pumice, EZ slide and resin on shoes and/or soft rubber soles or heels that rub off on the approach
 - a. Altering the surface of a bowling ball by use of abrasives after the start of competition is prohibited. Please refer to USBC Rule #18. Note: Start of competition - Bowling balls may be altered between the first and second set on Saturday, as these are considered two separate sets.
 - b. In each series, the start of competition is defined as the point the first ball is thrown by any participant for score.
9. In the Michigan Queen's tournament, entrants are requested to wear suitable attire. (No Jeans). Headgear may be worn for medical purposes only.

RULES FOR QUALIFYING ROUNDS;

1. Any bowler, not checked in at least 30 minutes prior to any scheduled start time, could be disqualified and her entry fee forfeited.
2. If in the qualifying rounds the final position needed to complete the field or alternate should result in a tie, one complete game shall immediately be bowled. Failure of any bowler to be available in the bowling center in case of a tie will constitute a forfeiture.

If a tie still exists at the end of a roll-off, a complete 9th and 10th frame will be bowled. The frames will be bowled on the same lanes on which each bowler finished the 10th frame.

If a tie still exists, bowlers will change lanes and bowl another complete 10th frame. This procedure will be followed until the tie is broken.
3. All other questions will be decided by the Tournament Director.

<p>Premature termination of the tournament brought on by war, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto or therefrom, fire, national disaster or any other reason beyond the control of the Michigan State USBC shall cause, to the extent required thereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective rounds up to the time of such termination.</p>
