## **LESIA LAMBERT-CONANT CAPTURES THE MDUSBC SENIOR QUEENS AT WESTLAND BOWL**

Lesia Lambert-Conant of Allen Park won the Metro Detroit USBC Senior Queens on Saturday with a 222-149 triumph over Cyndi Patterson of Taylor at Westland Bowl.

Lambert-Conant was the top qualifier for the stepladder finals with a four-game total of 969 on games of 246, 239, 217 and 267. Her final game, 267, was high score for the competition.

Patterson was the second seed for the stepladder with a four-game total of 939 on games of 254, 216, 265 and 204. In progressing to the final match, Patterson defeated fourth seed, Sekeithia Walters-Wright of Eastpointe 202-188.

Defending Champion, Julie Halstead of Redford, qualified third with a four-game total of 902 on games of 201, 239, 258 and 204 before losing her opening round to Walters-Wright 257-246.

Walters-Wright qualified fourth with a four-game total of 881 on games of 235, 202, 223 and 221.

This was the 18<sup>th</sup> year of the MDUSBC Senior Queens. Initial qualifying was done by senior women 50 years of age and older with their actual all-events of the recently completed MDUSBC Women's Championship. The top bowlers advanced to the qualifying finals.

The MDUSBC Senior Queens Tournament is operated by the Metro Detroit USBC the largest local association of the United States Bowling Congress.
