MEN'S AND SENIOR MEN'S TEAMS

Winter and Summer Sessions (Revised on 10/22/2025)

Points will be awarded in the following manner:

- All finishes are based on actual pinfall only and only first score in each event (doubles, singles, all-events) counts.
- Points will be given in the following tournaments on the basis of the top ten finishers. 15 for first, 12 for second, 10 for third, 8 for fourth, 6 for fifth, then 5-4-3-2-1.
- MDUSBC Open tournament doubles, singles and all events.
- Michigan State Open tournament doubles, singles and all events. This is the top ten finishers from the MDUSBC but must be in the top 100 places of the tournament. First, second or third overall in the tournament would receive bonus points of 10, 8, or 5 respectively.
- USBC Open tournament doubles, singles and all events. This is the top ten finishers from the MDUSBC, but must be in the top 100 places of the tournament. First, second or third overall in the tournament would receive bonus points of 10, 8, or 5 respectively.
- MDUSBC Masters - the top 32 finishers as follows:
25-20-15-10-6-6-5-5-4-4-4-4-3-3-3-3, 8 @ 2 and 8 @ 1.
- MDUSBC Senior Masters (only applies to the senior men's all-city team) – the top 32 finishers as follows:
25-20-15-10-6-6-5-5-4-4-4-4-3-3-3-3, 8 @ 2 and 8 @ 1.
- Michigan State Masters. This is the top ten finishers from the MDUSBC but must be in a cashing position of the tournament. First, second or third overall in the tournament would receive bonus points of 10, 8, or 5 respectively.
- Michigan State Senior Masters (only applies to the senior men's all-city team). This is the top ten finishers from the MDUSBC but must be in a cashing position of the tournament. First, second or third overall in the tournament would receive bonus points of 10, 8, or 5 respectively.
- MDUSBC Men's Series (starting in the 2025-26 season). 4 points for winning an event, 3 points for second, 2 points for third, 1 point for fourth and 10 points for winning the cup.
- For the each honor score game points will be as follows:
300 - 5 points 299 - 4 points 298 - 3 points
A maximum of 20 points can be earned in this category
- For the each honor score series points will be as follows:
826 & up - 5 pts 800-825 – 4 pts
A maximum of 20 points can be earned in this category
- Individuals will received points for their highest MDUSBC yearbook of 48 games or more as follows:
240 & up – 20 pts; 230-239 – 16 pts; 220-229 – 12 pts; 210-219 – 8 pts; 200-209 – 4 pts
- First and second teams will be named in the Men's and Senior Men's category

Eligibility for Senior Men's category must be 50 years of age by August 1 for the upcoming season.

WOMEN'S AND SENIOR WOMEN'S TEAMS

Winter and Summer Sessions (Revised on 10/22/2025)

Points will be awarded in the following manner:

- All finishes are based on actual pinfall only and only first score in each event (doubles, singles, all-events).
- Points will be given in the following tournaments on the basis of the top ten finishers. 15 for first, 12 for second, 10 for third, 8 for fourth, 6 for fifth, then 5-4-3-2-1.
- MDUSBC Women's tournament doubles, singles and all events.
- Michigan State Women's tournament doubles, singles and all events.
This is the top ten finishers from the MDUSBC but must be in the top 100 places of the tournament. First, second or third overall in the tournament would receive bonus points of 10, 8, or 5 respectively.
- USBC Women's tournament doubles, singles and all events.
This is the top ten finishers from the MDUSBC, but must be in the top 100 places of the tournament. First, second or third overall in the tournament would receive bonus points of 10, 8, or 5 respectively.
- MDUSBC Queens - the top 16 finishers as follows:
15-10-6-6-4-4-4-4 and 8 @ 2.
- MDUSBC Senior Queens – the qualifiers for the rolloff as follows:
15-10-6-4-2-1 for each of the others that qualify for the rolloff.
- Michigan State Queens.
This is the top ten finishers from the MDUSBC but must be in a cashing position of the tournament. First, second or third overall in the tournament would receive bonus points of 10, 8, or 5 respectively.
- Michigan State Senior Queens (only applies to the senior women's all-city team).
This is the top ten finishers from the MDUSBC but must be in a cashing position of the tournament. First, second or third overall in the tournament would receive bonus points of 10, 8, or 5 respectively.
- MDUSBC Women's Series (starting in the 2025-26 season). 4 pts for winning an event, 3 pts for second, 2 pts for third, 1 pt for fourth and 10 pts for winning the cup.
- Appropriate placing points awarded for placing in the respective Open Division event.
For the each honor score game points will be as follows:
300 - 5 pts; 299 - 4 pts; 298 - 3 pts; 290-297 – 2 pts; 279-289– 1 pt
A maximum of 20 points can be earned in this category
- For the each honor score series points will be as follows:
826 & up - 5 pts; 800-825 – 4 pts; 776-799– 3 pts; 741-775 – 2 pts; 700-740 – 1 pt
A maximum of 20 points can be earned in this category
- Individuals will received points for their highest MDUSBC yearbook of 48 games or more as follows:
240 & up – 20 pts; 230-239 – 16 pts; 220-229 – 12 pts; 210-219 – 8 pts; 200-209– 4 pts
- First and second teams will be named in the Women's and Senior Women's category.

Eligibility for Senior Women's category must be 50 years of age by August 1 for the upcoming season.
