RAYMOND CEREKAS WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Raymond Cerekas of Warren won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 184-144 triumph over Corey Miller of Waterford at Spins Bowl Waterford in Waterford. Cerekas took home the top prize of \$500, while Miller settled for \$250.

Cerekas qualified eighth in the field of 83, with a four-game total of 886 on games of 232, 226, 180 and 248. In match play he beat Gerald Sikora of Ecorse 235-227, John Robertson of Waterford 278-153 and Leandre Thomas of Novi to advance to the championship match.

Miller qualified second with 956, including a high game of 255. In match play he defeated Jonathan Ligenza of Farmington Hills 198-188, Carlos Granados of Orlando, Florida 208-183 and Mark Bilancetti of Redford 194-180 on his way to the finals.

Conner Lackey of Jackson led the field with 968 on games of 204, 254, 210 and 300. In losing his first match he took home \$75.
