COREY MILLER WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Corey Miller of Waterford won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 255-187 triumph over Charles Easton of Sylvania, OH, at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. Miller took home the top prize of \$500, while Easton settled for \$250.

Miller qualified tenth in the field of 77, with a four-game total of 876 on games of 180, 220, 235 and 241. In match play he beat Justin Knowles of Okemos 205-175, Jarrod Willbur of Walled Lake 172-160 and Gerald Johnson of Taylor 228-187 to advance to the championship match.

Easton qualified ninth with 878, including a high game of 248. In match play he defeated Phil Zocharski of Chelsea 214-141, Drake Bazzy of Flat Rock 215-170 and Dennis Johnson 216-215 on his way to the finals.

Bazzy led the field with 952 on games of 225, 259, 249 and 219. In losing his second match he took home \$100.
