MIKE LUCENTE WINS MEN'S SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Michael Lucente of Warren won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Men's Series event Sunday with a 244-243 victory over Frank Snodgrass of Center Line at Spins Bowl Waterford in Waterford. Lucente took home the top prize of \$500, while Snodgrass settled for \$250.

Lucente qualified sixth in the field of 65 with a four-game total of 920 on games of 225, 202, 235 and 258. In match play, he beat Jeff Austreng of Waterford 232-204, Jordan Born of White Lake 270-221 and Stephen Krywy of Sterling Heights 193-160 to advance to the championship match.

Snodgrass was the top qualifier with 987, including a 299 final game. In match play, he defeated Michael Brumitt of Lake Orion 259-185, Brian Odom of Romulus 289-170 and Jacob Johnson of Redford 279-193 on his way to the finals.

Stephen Krywy won the season long cup with 769 points, followed by Michael McCleskey of Southfield (731), Ryan Land of Royal Oak (677), Keith Caldwell of Detroit (651) and Mark Meinema of Zeeland (642). The cup and season long prize money will be awarded at the final invitational event at Shelby Lanes on May 2.

After the competition Lucente defeated Women's Series winner Julia Huren of Westland 248-184 in the Battle of the Series for \$100 "cold cash" and bragging rights. This gives the men a 5-3 advantage over the women in this extra competition.
