SANDRA SCHULTZ WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Sandra Schultz of Macomb won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 222-173 triumph over Emilee Hughes of Auburn Hills at Spins Bowl Waterford in Waterford. Schultz took home the top prize of \$500, while Hughes settled for \$250.

Schultz qualified third in the field of 47, with a four-game total of 823 on games of 256, 134, 215 and 218. She earned a bye in the first round, but once match play began she beat Tanisha Burris of Holt 235-174 and Sheri Verespej of Newport to advance to the finals.

Hughes qualified fourth with 798, which included games of 201, 237, 203 and 157. She also earned a bye and then defeated Rachel Lawrence of Westland 188-141 and Angela Wilt of Westland 192-163 on her way to the finals.

Stacey Timmer of Wayland was the top qualifier with 913, including a high game of 248. She lost her first match to Wilt 194-188 to end her day. She cashed for \$75.
