ROBIN ORLIKOWSKI WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Robin Orlikowski of Grand Rapids won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 235-159 triumph over Julia Huren of Westland at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. Orlikowski took home the top prize of \$500, while Huren settled for \$250.

Orlikowski qualified fifth in the field of 38, with a four-game total of 846 on games of 229, 197, 208 and 212. She earned a bye in the first round, but once match play began she beat Deborah Murrell of Shelby Twp. 223-176 and Cathleen Maes of Westland 195 to 187 to advance to the finals.

Huren qualified tenth with 787, which included games of 168, 216, 178 and 225. In reaching the finals, she defeated Emilee Hughes of Auburn Hills, 246-182, Brandie Reamy-Johnson of Taylor 212-186 and Ashley Denard of Southfield 238-202 on her way to the finals.
