JULIA HUREN WINS WOMEN'S SERIES EVENT AT SPINS BOWL WATERFORD

Julia Huren of Westland won the Metro Detroit USBC (MDUSBC) Women's Series event Sunday with a 224-197 triumph over Kasey Eaton of Wyoming at Spins Bowl Waterford in Waterford. Huren took home the top prize of \$500, while Eaton settled for \$250.

Huren qualified third in the field of 29, with a four-game total of 878 on games of 235, 255, 193 and 195. In match play, she beat Julie Oczepek of Vassar 180-179 and Deborah Murrell of Shelby Township 245-189 to advance to the finals.

Eaton qualified fifth with 863 including a high game of 253. In match play, she triumphed over Sandra Schultz of Macomb 257-246 and top qualifier Lesia Lambert of Allen Park 222-202 on her way to the championship match.

Top game of the competition was a 300 by top qualifier Lambert, who shot 933.

Eaton won the season long cup with 811 points, followed by Huren (766), Cathleen Maes of Westland (723), Ashley Everett of Belleville (716) and Angela Wilt of Westland (693). The cup and season long prize money will be awarded at the final invitational event at Shelby Lanes on May 2.

After the competition Huren lost to Men's Series winner Michael Lucente of Warren 248-184 in the Battle of the Series for \$100 "cold cash" and bragging rights. This gives the men a 5-3 advantage over the women in this extra competition.
