## ANDREW ANDERSON LEADS QUALIFYING IN MDUSBC MASTERS AT BOWL ONE

The Metro Detroit USBC Masters tournament qualifying wrapped up at Bowl One Lanes in Troy Sunday, Jan. 22 with Andrew Anderson of Holly leading the 10-game qualifying round with 2,363.

Anderson, bowling in the Masters for the first time, averaged 236.2 for the two days of qualifying rounds. Five-game rounds of 1,229 and 1,134 propelled him to the lead. Anderson shot a high game of 279 and led qualifying by 50 pins over 2014 Masters champion Ronnie Sparks Jr. of Redford. Anderson had games of $215,243,235,257,279,278,192,276,197$ and 191. He receives a bye in the first round of match play on Saturday, Jan. 28.

Sparks had five-game qualifying blocks of 1,138 and 1,175 on Sunday to be seeded second. He also receives a bye in the first round along with places three through eight.

Defending champion John Nolen of Waterford Township is seeded ninth per tournament rule and will face Peter Kaczmarczyk of Warren

Other former champions making the cut were Mason Brantley of Detroit (2011), Terence Dockery of Fraser (1993), Kerry Kreft of Warren (2008) and Jeffrey Austreng of Waterford Township (2005 and 2007).

The field of 87 averaged 200.1, with the top 24 finalists averaging 221.8.
Anderson had the top qualifying block with 1,229.
Top game honors of 300 went to 16 -year-old Marcus McClain of Lincoln Park, who was bowling in his first Masters competition. McClain is the grandson of 1978 Masters champion Fred McClain.

Match play begins at 9 a.m. on Saturday, Jan. 28 at Bowl One Lanes in the double elimination threegame match play format. The final match is scheduled for Sunday, Jan. 29 at 1 p.m.
