SANDRA SCHULTZ CAPTURES THE MDUSBC SENIOR QUEENS AT WESTLAND BOWL

Sandra Schultz of Macomb won the Metro Detroit USBC Senior Queens on Saturday with a 234-226 triumph over Tanisha Burris of Holt at Westland Bowl.

Schultz was the fourth qualifier for the stepladder finals with a four-game total of 853 on games of 226, 213, 198 and 216. In progressing to the stepladder finals, Schultz defeated third seed Kamla Sand of Sterling Heights 212-181 and second seed Jeanne Gebbia of Dearborn 256-192 to reach the final match against Burris.

Burris was the top seed and had to wait for the challenger to emerge. She had a four game total of 972 with games of 300, 222, 193 and 257.

Gebbia qualified second with a four-game total of 944. Her totals included a high game of 258. In her first match, she lost to Schultz and finished third overall.

Sand qualified third with a four-game total of 857 on games of 184, 226, 198 and 249 before losing her opening match against Schultz.

This was the 17th year of the MDUSBC Senior Queens. Initial qualifying was done by senior women 50 years of age and older with their actual all-events of the recently completed MDUSBC Women's Championship. The top bowlers advanced to the qualifying finals.

The MDUSBC Senior Queens Tournament is operated by the Metro Detroit USBC the largest local association of the United States Bowling Congress.
