TROY STUS WINS BACK TO BACK MDUSBC SENIOR MASTERS AND CLAIMS \$2,000 FIRST PRIZE AT PLAZA LANES

Defending champion, Troy Stus of South Lyon, won the 32nd Annual Metro Detroit USBC Senior Masters Tournament at Plaza Lanes in Plymouth. In the final match, he defeated Michael Calvin of Warren 462-420 in this two-game double elimination championship. In claiming the title, Stus was the lone survivor in the winner's bracket remaining undefeated throughout the tournament and claimed the \$2,000 first prize. For the second-place finish, Calvin earned \$900.

In the qualifying round, Stus finished 25th with a six-game total of 1,242 and a high game of 241. Though only the Top 24 qualified for match play competition, Stus received an automatic ninth seed as defending champion. In match play, he defeated Harold Sullins of Chesterfield 481-423, Lonnie Olsen of Macomb 449-372, Bo Goergen of Sanford 409-391, the first match with Calvin 397-322 and Bradley Gray of Farmington Hills 461- 432 to advance to the final match. Over the two-day tournament, Stus averaged 216.72 for 18 games.

Calvin finished 21st in the qualifying round with 1,251. In match play, he defeated Larry Walker of Garden City 450-385, Dominico Emmi of Macomb 460-439, John Goormastic Jr of Westland 482-438 before losing to Stus 397-322 in their first match of the day. In the losers bracket, he defeated Jeffrey Austreng of Waterford 499-453, Goergen 454-425 and Gray 459-404 setting up the rematch against Stus. Throughout the competition, Calvin averaged 218.05 over 22 games.

Gray qualified 14th with 1,284. He first defeated Stephen Barry of Sterling Heights 416-401 then Gary Brown Jr of Gregory 370-368, Gary Duarard Jr of Livonia 387-374 and Frank Camilleri of Brownstown 429-401 before losing to Stus 461-432. In the losers bracket, he lost to Calvin 459-404. He averaged 206.78 over 18 games settling for third place for \$800.

Goergen was the top qualifier with 1,435. In match play, he defeated Gerald Johnson of Taylor 458-407, before falling to into the loser's bracket with a loss to Stus 409-391. In the losers bracket he defeated John Chapman of Brampton 480-427, Goormastic 396-330, and Camilleri 443-425 before losing to Calvin 454-425. Goergen averaged 223.78 for 18 games of competition and settled for the fourth place check of \$750.

In the second day of competition, Goormastic bowled the sole 300 game of the tournament.

The MDUSBC Masters Tournament is a USBC certified event operated by the Metro Detroit USBC, the largest local association of the United States Bowling Congress which serves over 30,000 adult and youth bowlers in the Metropolitan Detroit market.
