Format:	Each bowler shall bowl four games over eight lanes moving after each game. After qualifying, the top players will advance to match play on a 1 in 4 ratio. Match play will be one-game singles elimination matches. All bowlers must be 18 years or older on the event date.			
Awards:	First place \$500, second place \$250. All prizes based on 24 entries.

RULES & REGULATIONS - WOMEN'S SERIES

- 1. This is an individual match game event open to all USBC certified female adult members. Must be 18 years or older on event date.
- 2. Entry costs are \$45 per individual paid in advance. \$50 if paid on day of the tournament.
- 3. Qualifying for match play on a 1 in 4 ratio, maximum of 24 in match play.
- 4. In the case of a tie for the final match play position, one additional game will be bowled by those bowlers tied. Should a tie still exist after this game, one (1) extra frame will be rolled on the same lane which each participant finished the game. Bowler on the odd lane will shoot first, but instead of completing the frame, the contestants will alternate shots until broken.
- 5. In the event of a tie for any other position, the player with the highest game will be placed in the higher position. Should a tie still exist, then the next highest game will be used.
- 6. If a match ends in a tie, a 9th and 10th frame roll-off will be bowled to break the tie with each bowler starting on the lane where they finished the match. As in all other games, the bowler on the odd lane will start.
- 7. Each match will be one game to determine the winner. Pairings for the initial round of matches will be based on the finish of the contestants in qualifying round. Pairings will continue on a bracket system. In the final match play game, the bowler with the higher qualifying seed will have choice of starting lane after practice has ended.
- 8. Qualifying round will be four games total pinfall over eight lanes moving after each game.
- 9. All bowling equipment must be approved by USBC and no bowling ball can be used prior to release date to the public. If found using either of the above, the bowler will be disqualified.
- 10. All participants will receive points based on their finish towards a season long "Cup" prize list.

Cup

All participants receive points based on their finish (except Mixed Baker Doubles).

In each of the first three events first place will receive 100 points, second place 99 points and on down.

First place finish will receive an additional 20 points and runner-up and additional 10 points.

In the fourth event points are doubled. First place will receive 200 points, second place 198 points and on down.

First place finish will receive an additional 40 points and runner-up an additional 20 points.

In the fifth event points are tripled. First place will receive 300 points, second place 297 points and on down First

place finish will receive an additional 60 points and runner-up an additional 30 points.

Points for players eliminated in the same round are based on qualifying position.

At the end of the five events the top 16 players based on points will share in the prize fund as follows

(ties will split the money)

- 1.\$600
- 2.\$300
- 3. \$200
- 4. \$150
- 5. \$100

6th - 16th \$ 75 each

Rip 10 Invitational: The top 16 players in points, winners of individual events and

every player that participates in all five events will be invited.

Baker Doubles special rules

- 1. This special event is designed to introduce new players to the Women's & Men's Series.
- 2. Each team must consist of 1 female and 1 male player.
- 3. All above rules apply except as modified by these special rules.
- 4. Each player will bowl four games. 1 in 4 teams will advance to match play based on the total qualifying score of both players.
- 5. Match play will consist of two Baker Format games with total pins of the two games determining the match play score.
