**COREY MILLER WINS 2025 MDUSBC MASTERS
AND CLAIMS \$2,800 FIRST PRIZE AT THUNDERBOWL LANES**

Ten years after winning his first Masters Title, Corey Miller of Waterford won the 62nd Annual Metro Detroit USBC Masters Championship by defeating Dylan Jablonski of Canton in the two-game match 451-412 at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. In claiming the title, Miller took home the first prize of \$2,800 which includes \$300 from event supporter, Turbo 2-N-1 Grips. For his second-place finish, Jablonski earned \$1,400.

Miller qualified 10th with a six game total of 1,405 and a high game of 266. In match play, he defeated Ed Burbo of Belleville 503-484, Charles Easton of Toledo 590-432, John Kelley of Clinton Twp. 448-420 and Carter Milasinovich of Shelby Twp. 494-321 to advance to the final match round. Still in the Winners Bracket, Miller received his first loss in the double elimination format to Jablonski 425-488. In the final winner take all match, Miller beat Jablonski 451-412. During his match against Easton, Miller had a perfect game of 300 and a second game with 11 in a Row for 290. Over the two-day tournament, Miller averaged 239.78 for 18 games.

Jablonski qualified 13th with a six-game total of 1,268 with a high game of 269. In match play, he defeated John Roberston of Waterford 506-478, then lost his first match to JR Raymond of Clinton Twp. 453-504 to fall into the loser's bracket. In the loser's bracket he beat Carleton Chambers of Detroit 462-370, Perry Crowell of St. Clair Shores 556-461, Kelley 520-479, Easton 493-408, and Milasinovich 476-470 then moved to the final matches against Miller. He averaged 238.92 for 24 games of competition.

After qualifying first with a six-game total of 1,541, Milasinovich finished third. In match play, he defeated Ian Wright of Westland 493-421, Crowell 449-432 and Raymond 463-408 before losing to Miller 494-321. In the loser's bracket he suffered his second defeat and elimination to Jablonski. In the fifth game of qualifying, Milasinovich rolled a perfect 300 game. He averaged 233.56 for 16 games and earned \$1,200.

Fourth place finisher, Easton, qualified second with a six-game total of 1,457. He won his first match against Anthony Dimuzio of Warren 462-410 before losing to Miller 590-432. He remained in the loser's bracket by defeating Wright 463-433, Devon Osborn of Farmington Hills 464-457 and Raymond 508-495. Easton received his second loss to Jablonski 470-476. He averaged 233.00 for 18 games and earned \$900.
