



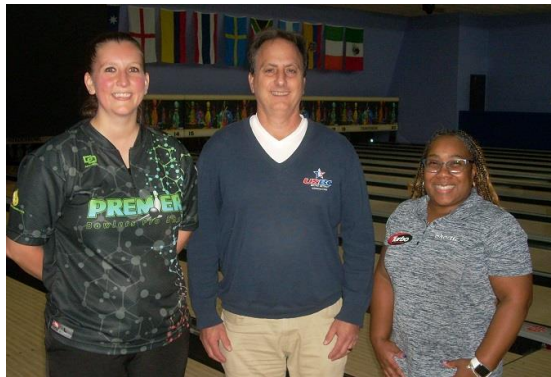

KRISTIN TRUSZKOWSKI WINS MDUSBC QUEENS AT THUNDERBOWL LANES

Kristin Truszkowski of Livonia defeated Shannon Rowe of Westland 194-162 in the final match to win the MDUSBC Queens at Thunderbowl Lanes in Allen Park. Truszkowski won the title and \$1,300, while Rowe settled for \$500.

Truszkowski qualified in the sixth position with a six-game total of 1,278 on games of 237, 194, 195, 216, 226 and 210. In match play, she beat Taylor Thomas of Southfield 205-184, Bailey Gipson of Davison 211-192 and Emily Rettig of Novi 195-185 on her way to the final match. She averaged 208.3 for 10 games of competition.

Rowe qualified 11th with 1,229 with a high game of 233. In match play, she beat defending champion Tanisha Burris of Holt 224-200, Kara Strong of Florence, KY 214-190 and Jenna Pollak of Fraser 245-204 leading to the championship match. She averaged 207.4 for 10 games.

In losing her opening match, defending champion Burris earned \$75.

The top four non-cashing seniors, 50 years and older, earned \$60 each. This group included Angela Wilt of Westland, Julie Halstead of Redford Twp, Toary Taylor of West Bloomfield and Sheri Verespej of Newport.
